The Final Solution (German: Die Endlösung) was a plan made by the Nazi Germany to kill millions of Jews and Gypsies (Roma and Sinti people of Romania and many other European countries) during World War II. On July 31 1941, Nazi leader Hermann Goering ordered the SS to make plans for a "complete solution of the Jewish question."

The "Final Solution of the Jewish Question" was the euphemistic term used by the Nazi German authorities to refer to the plan to annihilate European Jewry.
