History of: -Type of pain, nature and onset, location, quality. -LBM, Change in bowel habits. -Ask about history of trauma, gynecological history, anorexia, malaise. Assess for tachycardia, HTN, fever, nausea/vomiting. Inspect - look for bruising (pancreatitis) listen - for bowel sounds.
